

New Zealand Darts Council 180 badges

The following is the process to claim 180's:

- 1. 180 claims must be made on the appropriate form New Zealand Darts Council (NZDC) Application for 180 Badges, or a local computer version approved by NZDC.
- 2. Only one application on each form, signed by the opponent, chalker/caller, and the Association Secretary or Badge Controller.

Multiple applications on the one form will not be accepted.

The local association Secretary or Badge Controller is responsible for forwarding the 180 claim forms to the appropriate NZDC badge controller for their members. Applications must be on the official form and signed off by the Association Secretary or Badge Controller. Claims should be forwarded to the South Island or North Island 180 Badge Controller with the cover sheet regularly, preferably monthly. No applications can be received from individual persons.

An NZDC '180 North or South Island Batch Claim form NZDC' must be used as a cover sheet on all claim applications. If batches arrive without the proper cover sheet, they will be sent back for this to be completed.

The conditions which a player can claim a 180 badge are:

- 1. The player MUST be a registered member of NZDC
- 2. Any event or stage of the NZDC Championships
- 3. Any game under the direct control of an affiliated Association or Region of NZDC
- 4. The game must finish on a double and not to exceed 1001.

The first 180 Badge is issued. upon checking the above conditions, and any future badges, will be free of charge. Replacement badge requests are to be sent to the NZDC General Secretary using NZDC 1a Order form and will be issued upon receipt of payment. Please refer to online forms, NZDC website.

Solid badges (no inserts) are issued as follows:

No. 1 badge	No. 100 badge, No. 250, No. 500, No. 750
No. 10 badge	No. 1000 badge, No. 1500, and No. 2000
No. 20 badge	
No. 50 badge	170 finish badge (first only)

To claim a 170 Finish badge, complete the 180 application form, cross out 180 and write 170 Finish. The application must be signed by the opponent, chalker/caller and the Association Secretary or Badge Controller. This is to be forwarded to the Badge Controller for processing. Note the first 170 Finish will receive a badge, any further 170 Finishes can be claimed, but will not receive a badge.

NOTE: Any claims older than six months will not be accepted.
