On behalf of the Directors of New Zealand Darts Council, I would like to announce that a Prize Pool of \$5,000 for 9 Dart Leg game has been set up for the 2021 year. The following are the details:

Prize Pool: \$5,000

Period: 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021

Details: The 9 dart leg game will apply to all tournaments under the auspice of the New Zealand

Darts Council. These tournaments are:

Canterbury Classic South Island Masters North Island Masters Canterbury Open Puma NZ Masters

Taranaki Open (NZDC Registered Players only)

Puma NZ Open

NZ Singles (NZDC Championships)

Auckland Open

Alan King Memorial Open (Otago)
Ted Clements Memorial Open (Levin)

Conditions:

- 1. Player must be registered with NZDC before the commencement of the tournament. This means the money and paperwork for registration must be in the hands of the Director responsible for registrations.
- 2. Application for a 9 dart leg game must be made to the NZDC on an approved form this will be posted on the NZDC Website and will be forwarded to the Host Association of the tournament. The Application will be signed by the Applicant, the Opponent, the Chalker, the Tournament Director and the Secretary of the Host Association. It must also be accompanied by a photo of the scoresheet.
- 3. Where there are multiple applications, the prize pool will be split equally and this will be done in December 2021 and paid out in January 2022.
- 4. The NZDC reserves the right to review the above at any time and due notice will be provided.
