3. "It is forbidden for any Youth or Under 23 player to drink any form of alcoholic beverage during a WDF Sanctioned Event. Random Alcohol test may occur at any time during a WDF Sanctioned Event" (rules section 16.01.)
4. In the event that we do not have 4 girls and 4 open youth entries, a mixed tournament shall be held following the boy's format.

5. No headwear (hats, caps etc. or headphones, earpods) to be worn whilst playing or scoring. **Only headwear for religious purposes may be worn.**
6. No PDC, DPA or DPNZ logos on players shirts.
